We are asking the Board for their approval of a contract with the Joseph P. Camozzi Dairy. The amount of funding will not exceed \$40,000. We will be using SWRCB 12-401-251 Laguna de Santa Rosa Dairy Enhancement funds. The purpose of this project is to reduce nutrient loading to the Laguna de Santa Rosa watershed by funding priority infrastructure improvements on dairies. The project was identified in the Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plan (CNMP) titled Joe Camozzi Dairy dated 11/16/2012 by Paul Souza of Western United Environmental Services. The need and feasibility was documented by NRCS Engineering Inventory and Evaluation conducted by Carolyn Jones, Bay/Delta Team Agricultural Engineer, on 2/12/2013. NRCS is providing cost share through EQIP. The landowner will also be providing at least 10% cost share. We will contract directly with the landowner and our funds will go towards engineering and material costs.

6-3 **Approval on Board direction on RCD assisting with the permitting of instream dam**The RCD Board feels this project should move forward as it was requested by the California
Department of Fish and Wildlife. RCD staff will assist with the 1600 permit application so long as the

landowner has sincere interest in completing restoration work, works cooperatively with RCD staff, will be the applicant on the permit, maintains the bypass flow from the structure, pays 100% of the permit cost and pays at least 50% of the total project (whichever is greater), and that the grant funds will cover RCD time spent working on the project. This decision is not policy-setting, and each project of this type will be discussed by the Board.

6-4 Resolution 2016-02 to Authorize Agreement with CA Department of Fish and Wildlife for the Upper Green Valley Creek Fish Passage Implementation Project

The Upper Green Valley Fish Passage Implementation Project, will address a significant instream fish passage barrier in upper Green Valley Creek and stabilize the grade through a 600-ft reach. The project will upgrade a private road culvert that is a widely recognized barrier to coho salmon, thus restoring fish passage for juvenile and adult Coho to 4,810 ft of high quality rearing and intermediate spawning habitat. Another partial barrier upstream of the culvert, an abandoned concrete grade control structure and apron, will also be removed. Additionally, the project will preserve the upstream floodplain connectivity, stabilize the grade throughout the reach, and arrest the incising.
