SUBJECT: Financial Summary Report for July 2020

DATE: September 17, 2020

This report covers the first month of our new fiscal year beginning on July 1. As it is the first month of the quarter, estimates of revenue have been included for invoices billed only once quarterly.

GRRCD's **accounts receivable** is \$392,002 plus a **retention receivable** (grant funds withheld pending closure) of \$34,429 for a total of \$426,431 receivable from grant activity, a decrease from June of \$43,275.

The unexpended portion of our advances to date totals \$74,225 and appears as deferred revenue (a liability) on the balance sheet. This represents all advance payments from various sources less expenditures to date.

Our county bank balance is in the positive at \$334,533. The positive balance reflects receipt of our promissory note of \$500,000 on April 30th. Our payroll account at Exchange Bank has a positive balance of \$39,141, an advance funds account at the same bank is holding \$473 as well as a small donations account of \$120. Gold Ridge's prepaid expense of \$16,923 represents prepayments for liability, workers compensation and truck insurance for the 2020-2021 fiscal year. Prepaids for the 2019-2020 fiscal year have been fully written off.

The **accounts payable** balance is \$116,423 compared to \$170,861 in the prior month, a decrease of \$54,438. Other items include a credit card credit of \$328, net pension liability (GASB 68), deferred revenue as noted above and reflecting last fiscal year's GASB update, paid time off liability (compensated absences) as well as funds owing Cal Pers retirement, payroll taxes and our voluntary 457 retirement plan if unpaid at month's end.

Our **equity** this month is at a positive \$145,151 compared to \$154,115 at the end of June, a decrease of \$8,964 representing net loss for the first month of this fiscal year.

**The Statement of Operations** for July reports \$64,865 in revenue and \$73,829 in expenses (including principal payments on the truck) for a net loss of 8,964 for the month.

We await our upcoming audit and GASB68 report this fall.

#### **Definitions:**

- Statement of Net Assets (the balance sheet) lists all our assets, both cash and noncash:
- Assets include our cash in bank, funds expected from our grant activity but not yet received
  ("accounts receivable" and "retention receivable"), prepaid expenses, and the value of our
  physical assets.
- *Liabilities* are made up of money we owe to vendors, cash advances from grantors, credit card and payroll liabilities.
- Equity is the difference between our assets and liabilities or net worth as an organization.



- Net Income is the difference between assets and liabilities in this Fiscal Year
- Statement of Operations shows income and expenses for the current period.

### **Summary**

Staff requests approval for the Executive Director to enter a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Fire Safe Sonoma (FSS) for the shared position of the CivicSpark Fellow. The MOU outlines the purpose, role and responsibilities of both entities as it pertains to shared position to increase outreach and education on fire and forest resources in Sonoma County.

### **Background**

Since 2018 post the Tubbs Fire Gold Ridge and Sonoma RCDs have been working to build a strong partnership with Fire Safe Sonoma (FSS). All parties agree we will have better success being prepared for wildfire and wildfire recovery if we work closely together. We have jointly worked on several grants to both increase the areas in the county with Community Wildfire Protection Plans, implementation of those plans and increasing the capacity of the RCDs and Fire Safe Sonoma to serve the great need for property and individual preparedness in the face of wildfires. In early 2020 Fire Safe Sonoma received a contract from the County of Sonoma and we decided to go after a CivicSpark Fellow to assist with the capacity building for the RCDs and FSS.

The RCD is acting as the Fellow sponsor while FSS is providing the funding for this position. The MOU details the roles and responsibilities of each entity to ensure a productive and positive working experience.

### **Fiscal Information**

Fire Safe Sonoma will reimburse Gold Ridge RCD for the full cost of \$26,000. Gold Ridge RCD will provide mentorship and support for this employee. The Executive Director will be her supervisor. Gold Ridge RCD may assist in providing a work from home stipend commiserate with rest of the staff which is currently \$60/month, prorated by hours worked.

### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

## GOLD RIDGE RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND FIRE SAFE SONOMA REGARDING CIVICSPARK FELLOWSHIP

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is entered into by and between the Gold Ridge Resource Conservation District ("RCD") and Fire Safe Sonoma ("FSS") to be effective upon execution.

WHEREAS, the RCD contracted with the Local Government Commission ("LGC") CivicSpark Program, a federally funded AmeriCorps program operated by LGC, in which LGC recruits, hires, and supervises emerging professionals to provide services to the RCD and FSS that will result in effective actions to conserve natural resources and prepare residents for wildfire in Sonoma County ("the Position"); and

WHEREAS, FSS has financial support from the County of Sonoma for the Position for one year, but this support is not guaranteed ongoing support; and

WHEREAS, the RCD and FSS wish to jointly support and be supported by the Position using financial resources in addition to any support that may be provided by FSS via the County of Sonoma; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate for the RCD and FSS to enter into a memorandum of understanding setting out the responsibilities of the aforementioned parties with respect to such a Position.

### NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE RCD AND FSS AS FOLLOWS:

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this MOU is to coordinate activities and efficiently use the resources of the RCD and FSS in carrying out forest and fire related outreach activities within Sonoma County. The Position Job Description is provided in the attached Exhibit A and made part of this MOU.

### To further this purpose:

### A. RCD will:

- 1. Contract with LGC for the Position for an anticipated per year for the term of this MOU is 1,700 hours.
- 2. Provide the office space and supervision, to fulfill the duties of the Position.
- 3. Provide quarterly invoices to FSS for the Position. Notifications are typically sent out with a 30-day notice.
- 4. Coordinate with Sonoma Resource Conservation District (SRCD) on how Fellow can provide assistance to SRCD.

- 5. Meet with FSS and SRCD on a semi-annual basis (or more frequently at the request of FSS or SRCD) to review the Position, adherence to the Job Description (Exhibit A), and to discuss status of hours allocated to the RCD and FSS.
- 6. Performance appraisals, correspondence with LGC and any necessary disciplinary action will be handled by the RCD. Input will be requested from FSS.
- 7. Provide the necessary administrative oversight for the Position. The main point of contact for daily management of the Position will be Brittany Jensen, Gold Ridge RCD Executive Director.

### B. FSS will:

- 1. Provide funding for position equal to \$26,000 invoiced at \$6,500 on a quarterly basis or prorated based on Fellow's hours worked.
- 2. Provide a laptop, phone and other equipment required for Position to work remotely. If Fellow uses their own equipment FSS will provide a \$60/mo stipend directly to Fellow paid on a scheduled agreed upon with Fellow and FSS.
- 3. Meet with the RCD on a semi-annual basis (or more frequently at the request of the RCD) to review the Position, adherence to the authorized Job Description (Exhibit A), and to discuss status of hours allocated to each entity.
- 4. Provide input for Position's performance appraisal. FSS will also keep the RCD Executive Director apprised of any performance issues throughout the term of this MOU.
- 5. Provide necessary guidance to properly carry out the activities associated with projects within FSS's sphere of influence.

### **Distribution of Position Hours**

The work hours identified above may shift between partners by mutual written agreement.

### **Status of Lead RCD**

For all work performed under this MOU, the RCD shall be classified as a subcontractor, unless otherwise identified (through written notice to Gold Ridge RCD) as a subrecipient.

### **Effective Date and Duration**

This MOU shall become effective September 1, 2020 and shall be in effect until August 30, 2021, or such time as may be extended by permissible delays.

### <u>Amendment</u>

This Memorandum of Understanding may only be amended pursuant to a written agreement executed by all parties hereto.

### **Termination**

Any party may withdraw from this MOU, without cause and without liability to the other party, by providing the other party written notice of intention to do so thirty (30) days prior to the effective date of withdrawal. The rights and obligations of such party hereunder shall terminate thirty (30) days after the date of mailing such notice.

### **Coverage and Liability**

Gold Ridge RCD is a member of Special Districts Risk Management Authority (SDRMA), a self-insured Joint Powers Authority (JPA) formed under California Government Code §6500, et seq., and will provide all required insurance.

### **Notice**

All notices and other communications required or permitted to be given under this MOU, including any notice of change of address, shall be in writing and given by personal delivery, or deposited with the United States Postal Service, postage prepaid, addressed to the parties intended to be notified. Notice shall be deemed given as of the date of personal delivery, or if mailed, upon the date of deposit with the United States Postal Service. Notice shall be given as follows:
