- Include a TEAM Field Notebook designed to reinforce program themes

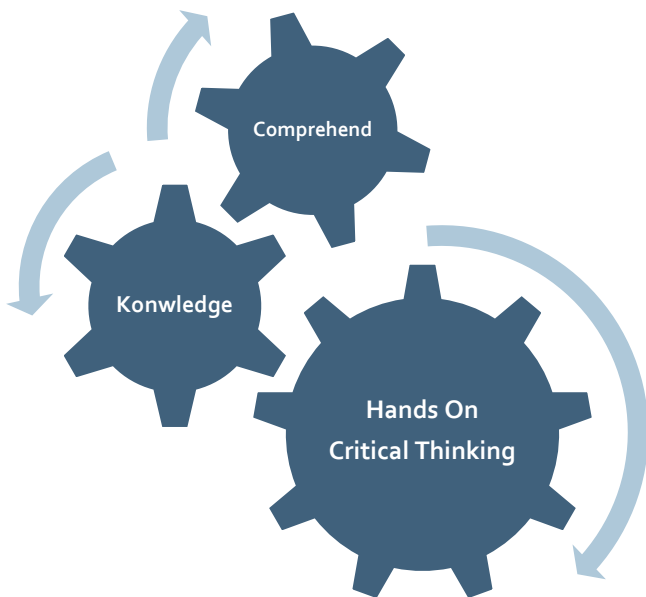
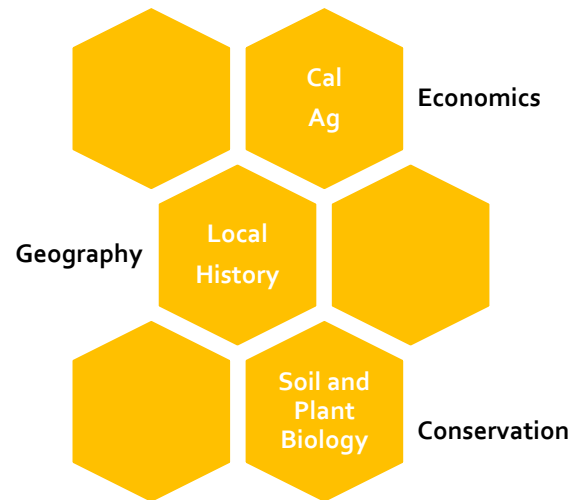

# Field Trip Duckworth Farm



Students will participate in:

- ✓ 50 minute pre-site classroom visit
- ✓ 3 ½ hour field trip to Open Field Farm
- ✓ 50 minute post-site classroom visit

While onsite, students will rotate through three workstations where hands-on activities will allow students to explore the wildlife habitat on the farm and learn about land stewardship and community connections:

**Station 1:** How to Raise a Sheep

**Station 2:** Weaving with Sheep's Wool

**Station 3:** Blueberry Farming!

**Ag Lesson:** Diverse Farms are Healthy Farms
